For the past few seasons of the Opera Rara festival, we have been accompanied by Schubert's 'Winterreise,' performed for instance by Ian Bostridge, who this time will sing another canonical song cycle, both akin to and polemical with the former 'Dichterliebe', composed thirteen years after 'Winterreise' by Robert Schumann, featuring the poems of Heinrich Heine. While in Schubert's work the protagonist ends his journey listening to the melody played by an old lyre player, in Schumann's piece the finale resounds with a call to lock all songs, dreams, and sentiments in a coffin and bury them deep in the water.

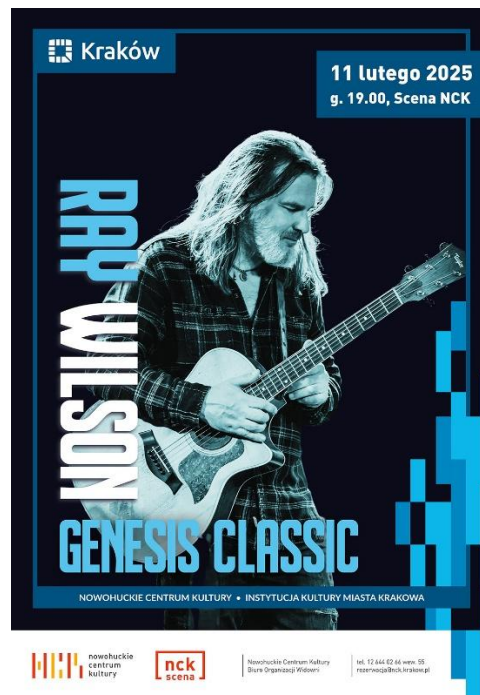
